So help support charities, maybe win some money along the way!



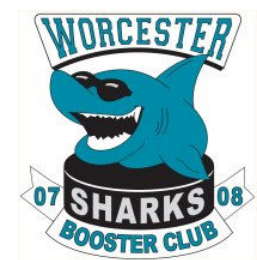

The club congratulates them for their support - it is greatly appreciated!

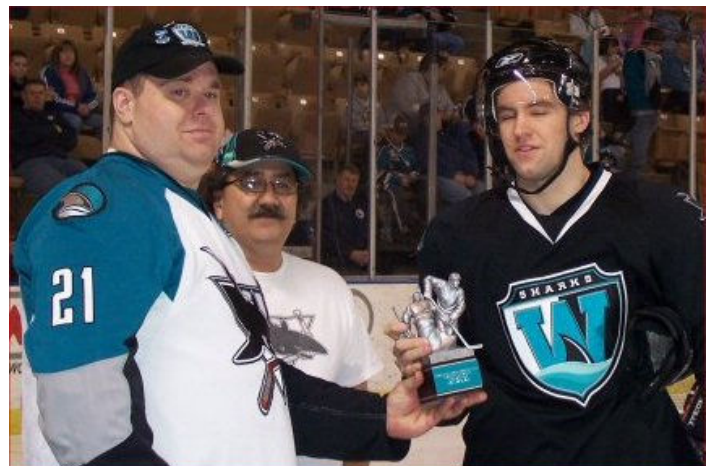
## PLAYER OF THE MONTH FEBRUARY - TOM CAVANAUGH!
