Everyone was greeted with a big platter of goodies at their table (thanks Chris!), and the night was started with some casual mingling and banter. The DCU Center provided a great (as usual) buffet, which many went for seconds! After dinner, Mrs. Claus (Chris) gave presents to all the kids in attendance, and then the players received their gifts. But the night was far from over. In a custom started three years ago, all the rookies were asked to come up to the podium and tell a story from Christmas past - whether good or bad. The guys were really caught off guard and had to think quickly. Some truly hilarious stories ensued, and it really helped create a mood for the rest of the night.

But what makes this event most important is what we do for charity—and has been our custom, for Friendly House. # AAHLBC BOOSTER CLUB CONVENTION 2014

It's time to think about the annual AAHLBC convention that is held in various cities around the AHL every September to celebrate our hockey, our hockey teams, our love of hockey and our friendships. It's a great way to start off officially our hockey season

The 2014 AAHLBC which is the 50<sup>th</sup> one will be held in **Pittsburgh, PA on September 5-7, 2014** at the Doubletree Hotel in downtown Pittsburgh and will be co-hosted by the Philadelphia Firebirds and the Pittsburgh Penguins Booster Clubs.

## Here are the particulars that you need to know!

Being such a special anniversary for us we would like to see many past attendees as well as new ones try to come join us for this weekend.

**Prices are \$340/single, \$230/double, \$190/triple and \$175/quad** – These prices are per person for Friday- Sunday and include 2 breakfasts (Sat & Sun) and two dinners (Fri & Sat) and your hotel stay.

The hotel only has valet parking at \$17/day but the Pittsburgh Club will pick up one night (Fri) and the AAHLBC will pick up the other night (Sat) and you will only be responsible for parking if you arrive early or leave late.

If you intend to arrive early in Pittsburgh the room rates would be \$112.86/per room /per night inclusive of taxes for September 3&4 and then the \$17/day parking for those days.

When calling the hotel 1 412-281-5100 ask for the HLB for the AAHLBC convention rate for those two days. REMINDER – YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR YOUR EARLY ARRIVALS OR LATE DEPARTURES THEY ARE NOT INCLUDED IN THE CONVENTION PRICES UP ABOVE DEADLINE FOR EARLY ARRIVAL RESERVATIONS IS AUGUST 4,2014 SO DON'T DELAY

**A \$50 non refundable deposit id due to the club (checks made out to Worcester Sharks Booster Club) by March 15, 2014 and the remaining balance is due on June 15, 2014**

The theme is Hockey through the Years –where you are encouraged to wear jerseys, t-shirts of your teams or past teams in homage to our history. This would be for the Friday night dinner.

For the Saturday formal dinner it would be nice with this being our 50<sup>th</sup> year that you come more formal than in years past. Suits & ties for the guys and formal dresses, pants suits, suits for the ladies!

## 50/50 ON GAME NIGHTS

I'm still looking for boosters to step up and help with volunteering some time for 50/50 before and during the games. Please see me during the games or shoot me an email to lend a hand-we will show you what needs to be done-no experience necessary. I thank Chris G and Judi for their help in our three home games so far. In November John W will be stepping in and doing some games as well with Chris and Judi. I'm taking names and availability for December and January now so please check your schedules and let me know -Thanks

Here is what you need to know: 1) You will need to be over 18. 2) You are asked to be there at least 15 minutes before the doors open to the public to help set up the tickets 3) You are at the table prior to the game until about the drop of the puck or a little after. 4) You are asked to be back by at least 5 minutes left in the periods to get ready for the intermission rush. 5) You are finished by the end of the 2nd intermission and free to enjoy the 3rd period. Everything is spelled out for you at the table and I'm always there to help if you need it.

Arrival for 7PM games 5:45PM, for 7:30 games 6:15PM and for 3PM games 1:45PM

## LOOKING FOR BROOMBALL PLAYERS

It looks like the 2014 AHLBC Broomball Tournament will be down in Hershey in July. This will be our 18th year coming up and we are in need of some fresh and younger legs to help out our many veterans on our team so I'm putting out the call to any and all boosters over 18 who can commit to practices through the fall, winter and spring and then the tournament come July. Other booster clubs that participate or have participated in the past are Hershey, Manchester, Providence, Philadelphia, Syracuse, WBS, Springfield, Albany, Adirondack (however the last 5 haven't been in it the last few years).

This is a Co-ed team so if you are interested please see or contact me for more details.

We are looking for boosters to come join the broomball team - requirements 18 yrs & older have your own equipment (helmet, pads, gloves, shoes and broom-although not all needed until you decide if you want to partake in the team). We hope to set a practice in late October or November to start - at least once a month to start and then maybe twice a month as the tournament gets closer. Our practice times aren't the best usually 11 PM or later, but sometimes we luck out and have them at 10 PM or even on Sunday mornings.

A few more things you need to know-Practice costs about \$20 per person each time we practice! Also there is a AHLBC broomball tournament fee that is split between the team so that is usually around \$40 per person
